GODLY LIVING (1 Peter 2:11-12)

- I. The TONE of the Appeal (1 Pet. 2:11*a*)
 - A. Addressed to those who are "BELOVED"
 - 1. Reflects admonition to LOVE ONE ANOTHER (cf. 1:22)
 - 2. Implies we are mutual OBJECTS of GOD'S LOVE
 - B. Stated as an APPEAL rather than a COMMAND
- II. The CONTENT of the Appeal (1 Pet. 2:11*b*-12*a*)
 - A. A call to godly INNER DISCIPLINE
 - 1. In relation to the WORLD we are "ALIENS and STRANGERS"
 - 2. In relation to SELF we are AT WAR with the FLESH
 - 3. The key to VICTORY is disciplining our hearts by the SPIRIT'S power
 - B. A call to godly OUTWARD DEPORTMENT
 - 1. Our BEHAVIOR is to be "EXCELLENT"
 - 2. Our BEHAVIOR is under the eye of the NATIONS

- III. The AIM of the Appeal (1 Pet. 2:12*b*)--
 - A. Secondarily, the VINDICATION of believers before a HOSTILE world
 - 1. They were accused of being "EVILDOERS"
 - a. REBELLION against the Roman GOVERNMENT
 - b. Practicing CANNIBALISM
 - c. Engaging in INCEST
 - d. SUBVERSIVE activities
 - e. Opposing SLAVERY
 - f. Practicing ATHEISM
 - g. HATRED of the people
 - 2. They should live in a way that PROVES the critics WRONG
 - B. Primarily, for the CONVERSION of the CRITICS (cf. Matt. 5:16)
 - 1. The will OBSERVE your GOOD DEEDS
 - 2. Some will GLORIFY God when He "VISITS" them
