SETTING THINGS RIGHT IN JUDAH (2 Kings 11:17-21)

- I. Restoring the COVENANT (2 Kings 11:17)
 - A. Vow BINDING the PEOPLE to the LORD
 - 1. They had FORSAKEN their true WORSHIP
 - 2. They had FORGOTTEN their true IDENTITY
 - B. Vow BINDING the KING to the LORD
 - 1. A reminder of God's PROMISE to DAVID
 - 2. A reminder of the KING'S obligation to LEAD the nation as a SHEPHERD of God's FLOCK
 - C. Vow BINDING the PEOPLE to the KING
- II. Removing the CORRUPTION (2 Kings 11:18)
 - A. TORE DOWN the TEMPLE of Baal
 - B. EXECUTED the priest of Baal
 - C. Placed GUARDS at the TEMPLE of God
 - 1. To protect from RETALIATION from Baal LOYALISTS or SUPPORTERS of Athaliah
 - 2. To provide SECURITY for the CORONATION PARADE

- III. Restoring the CROWN (2 Kings 11:19-21)
 - A. HONORING the king with a PARADE
 - 1. Led by the HIGH-PRIEST
 - 2. Included the King's BODYGUARD
 - 3. Included the MILITARY leadership
 - 4. Included the CIVIL leadership
 - 5. Included the RELIGIOUS leadership
 - B. PLACING the King on the THRONE
 - C. Establishing STABILITY in the city
 - 1. The people REJOICED
 - 2. The city was QUIET
 - 3. Athaliah was DEAD
 - 4. Joash was ON THE THRONE
- IV. Lessons
 - A. GENUINE faith must be PERSONAL
 - B. FAITHFULNESS to God leads to DESTRUCTION
 - C. The INVISIBLE HAND of God
