THE SAVIORS' SUFFERING (1 Peter 2:21*b*-25)

I. The Believers' Perfect STANDARD for Suffering (1 Pet. 2:21*b*-23)

- A. The NATURE of the pattern we are to FOLLOW
 - 1. Jesus' life provides a PATTERN for us to COPY
 - 2. Jesus' life left FOOTPRINTS for us to FOLLOW
- B. The DESCRIPTION of the pattern we are to FOLLOW
 - 1. He COMMITTED no SIN
 - 2. He SPOKE nothing DECEPTIVE
 - 3. He did not RETALIATE when INSULTED
 - 4. He made no THREATS when ABUSED
 - 5. Instead, He TRUSTED the RIGHTEOUS Judge
- II. The Believers' Perfect SUBSTITUTE in Suffering (1 Pet. 2:24)
 - A. The NATURE of His REDEMPTIVE suffering
 - 1. He took upon HIMSELF the entire WEIGHT of our SINS
 - 2. He PAID for our sins in His BODY on the CROSS

- B. The PURPOSE of His REDEMPTIVE suffering
 - 1. That we might DIE to SIN
 - 2. That we might LIVE to RIGHTEOUSNESS
- C. The RESULT of His REDEMPTIVE suffering: by His WOUNDS we are HEALED
- III. The Believers' Perfect SHEPHERD through Suffering (1 Pet. 2:25)
 - A. We were "CONTINUALLY STRAYING like sheep"
 - B. We are now under the CARE of CHRIST
 - 1. He's the SHEPHERD of our souls
 - 2. He's the GUARDIAN of our souls
