Joel 3 (2 Kings—supplemental, 26.3)

THE PROPHECY OF JOEL: PART 3 "THE DAY OF THE LORD" DESCRIBED (Joel 2:18 – 3:21)

- I. Introduction (Joel 2:18-20)
 - A. Assumes REPENTANCE has occurred (cf. 2:12-17)
 - B. Describes God's zealous RESPONSE
 - 1. Abundant PROVISION
 - 2. Destruction of their ENEMIES
- II. Promise of MATERIAL Restoration (Joel 2:21-27)
 - A. Do not FEAR, but REJOICE
 - 1. The LAND will FLOURISH
 - 2. The ANIMALS will THRIVE
 - B. God's PEOLE will enjoy BOUNTY
 - 2. All will acknowledge the LORD as the PROVIDER
 - 3. All will declare God's PRESENCE in their MIDST
- III. Promise of SPIRITUAL Restoration (Joel 2:28-32)
 - A. God will pour His SPIRIT on ALL MANKIND

- 1. Will be evidenced by PROPHECY, by DREAMS, and by VISIONS
- 2. Will not discriminate by GENDER, AGE, or STATUS
- 3. The Spirit's filling will occur AFTER the UNIVERSAL PROSPERITY
- B. God will demonstrate His POWER "in the SKY and on the EARTH"
- C. God will provide SALVATION
 - 1. He will save WHOEVER calls on His NAME
 - 2. Those He saves will be the ones whom THE LORD CALLS
- IV. Promise of NATIONAL Restoration (Joel 3:1-21)
 - A. Judah and Jerusalem will be RESTORED (cf. Hosea 6:11; Amos 9:14)
 - B. God will JUDGE the NATIONS
 - 1. The nations will be GATHERED
 - 2. Their sin is the ABUSE of ISRAEL
 - 3. NEIGHBORING nations will not be SPARED
 - 4. Humanity will prepare for WAR against GOD
 - 5. God will SLAUGHTER them EASILY (cf. Rev. 14:14-20)
 - C. God will BLESS Israel
 - 1. God will DWELL with them in a truly HOLY CITY
 - 2. The MOUNTAINS and HILLS will FLOURISH
 - 3. There will be ABUNDANT WATER
 - 4. He will AVENGE them of their ENEMIES
 - 5. Judah and Jerusalem will be inhabited in PEACE FOREVER
