## PROPER PERSPECTIVE ON *THE END*: HOW WE MUST LIVE (conclusion) (1 Peter 4:7-11)

- I. Its Impact on One's Personal Life (1 Pet. 4:7 *b*)
  - A. Should produce sound judgment (cf. Mark 5:15; Luke 8:35)
  - B. Should produce sober mindedness
  - C. Should produce appropriate prayer
- II. Its Impact on One's Public Life (1 Pet. 4:8-11)
  - A. Should produce mutual love (4:8)
  - B. Should promote mutual hospitality (4:9)

- C. Should PRACTICE mutual SERVICE (4:10-11a)
  - 1. Its NATURE
    - a. Supplied as a GIFT
    - b. Bestowed in the PAST upon EACH ONE
    - c. Provided for the BENEFIT of fellow BELIEVERS
    - d. Employed as STEWARDS
    - e. Ministers God's "MANIFOLD GRACE"

- 2. Its basic FORMS
  - a. The "SPEAKING" gifts
    - 1) Being conscious of God's AUTHORITY
    - 2) Being conscious of our ACCOUNTABILITY
  - b. The "SERVING" gifts
    - 1) Being conscious of personal RESPONSIBILITY
    - 2) Being conscious of natural INABILITY
- D. Should PROVOKE mutual PRAISE (4:11 *b*; cf. 1 Cor. 10:31)
  - 1. The GOAL of "all things" in the CHRISTIAN LIFE
  - 2. Possible only "THROUGH JESUS CHRIST"
    - a. Requires our TRANSFORMATION
    - b. Requires our SUBMISSION
  - 3. Ascribes to God "the GLORY and [the] DOMINION"
    - a. No one else DESERVES personal GLORY
    - b. No one else EXERCISES personal AUTHORITY
    - c. These belong only to GOD for ETERNITY
    - d. This truth is AFFIRMED by believers TODAY
