ESSENTIAL CHRISTIAN ATTITUDES, PART 1 (1 Peter 5:5-7)

- I. SUBMISSION (1 Peter 5:5a)
 - A. Means to WILLINGLY be SUBORDINATE to another
 - B. Addresses the command to "you YOUNGER MEN"
 - C. Instructs them to submit to "your ELDERS"
 - 1. Consciously avoid assuming their IDEAS are SUPERIOR
 - 2. Purposefully respect the WISDOM of MATURITY
- II. HUMILITY (1 Peter 5:5*b*-6)
 - A. Addressed to "ALL of you"
 - B. Means "LOWLINESS of mind" or "self-ABASEMENT"
 - 1. Secular culture did not consider it a VIRTUE
 - 2. It was considered characteristic of WEAKNESS and COWARDICE
 - C. Commanded to "CLOTHE YOURSELVES" with humility toward ONE ANOTHER
 - 1. God is OPPOSED to the PROUD

- 2. God gives GRACE to the HUMBLE
- D. Commanded to "HUMBLE yourselves" before GOD
 - 1. Because we are "UNDER" His "MIGHTY HAND"
 - 2. In order to be EXALTED at the APPROPRIATE TIME
- III. TRUST (1 Peter 5:7)
 - A. Expected to cast ALL your ANXIETY on Him
 - 1. Includes MEMORIES of the PAST
 - 2. Includes PRESSURES of the PRESENT
 - 3. Includes FEARS concerning the FUTURE
 - B. Assured that He CARES for YOU
