OPENING SALUTATION (2 Peter 1:1-2)

- I. The Writer's IDENTITY (2 Pet. 1:1a)
 - A. Uses the name given by his PARENTS: SIMON
 - B. Uses the name given by JESUS: PETER
- II. The Writer's STATUS (2 Pet. 1:1*b*)
 - A. A BOND-SERVANT of Jesus Christ
 - 1. He is TOTALLY OWNED by his Master
 - 2. He is constantly at the DISPOSAL of his Master
 - 3. He owe UNQUESTIONING OBEDIENCE to his Master
 - 4. He must be CONSTANTLY in the service of his Master
 - B. An APOSTLE of Jesus Christ
 - 1. One SENT FORTH to fulfill a MISSION
 - 2. Specifically, "an apostle of JESUS CHRIST"
- III. The Writer's AUDIENCE (2 Pet. 1:1c, cf. 3:1)
 - A. The same addressed in 1 PETER (cf. 1 Pet. 1:1)
 - 1. Believers SCATTERED through ASIA MINOR

- 2. Those CHOSEN "to OBEY Jesus Christ and be sprinkled with His BLOOD" (1 Pet. 1:1-2)
- B. Those possessing TRUE FAITH
- IV. The Readers' FAITH (2 Pet. 1:1c-d)
 - A. Its CHARACTER—a gift ALLOTTED to them
 - B. Its QUALITY—"the SAME KIND as OURS"
 - 1. The same in VALUE
 - 2. The same in EFFECT
 - C. Its SOURCE—"by the righteousness of our GOD and SAVIOR, Jesus Christ"
 - 1. On the basis of CHRIST'S righteousness imputed to US
 - 2. Given by JESUS, who is both GOD and SAVIOR
- V. The Writer's GREETING (2 Pet. 1:2; cf. 1 Pet. 1:2b)
 - A. GRACE: the FREE and UNDESERVED favor God bestowed upon the GUILTY through Jesus Christ
 - 1. Involves SATISFACTION of one's DEBT for PAST SIN
 - 2. Includes ENABLEMENT for DAILY LIVING
 - B. PEACE: the CONFIDENT sense of WELL-BEING that comes from knowing FORGIVENESS by God and RECONCILIATION to Him
 - C. KNOWLEDGE: Intimate UNDERSTANDING and EXPERIENCE of the truth revealed in Scripture
