SALVATION'S SUFFICIENCY, PART 1 (2 Peter 1:3-4)

- I. Divine PROVISION (2 Pet. 1:3*b*)
 - A. Affirms a TRUTH beyond DISPUTE
 - B. Emphasizes the SUFFICIENCY of our SALVATION
 - 1. Produces new LIFE by "CAUSING us to be BORN AGAIN" (1 Pet. 1:3)
 - Empowers GODLINESS of LIVING (cf. 1 Cor. 10:13; 12:13; 1 Pet. 5:10)
- II. Divine POWER (2 Pet. 1:3*a*)
 - A. Declares the SOURCE to be "His DIVINE POWER" (cf. Eph. 3:20)
 - 1. It comes from GOD, not OURSELVES
 - 2. It is UNLIMITED and cannot FAIL
 - B. Affirms that it is a divine ENDOWMENT
 - 1. It is APPOINTED by God's WILL
 - 2. It is a PERMANENT empowerment

C. Identifies the RECIPIENTS as "US"

III. Divine PROCUREMENT (2 Pet. 1:3c)

- A. Identifies the means as "through the TRUE KNOWLEDGE of HIM..."
 - 1. It is communicated CONSCIOUSLY
 - 2. It is not to be confused with FALSE KNOWLEDGE
- B. Identifies the CAUSE as "Him who CALLED US"
- C. Validates His calling "by His own GLORY and EXCELLENCE"
 - 1. It is an affirmation of Christ's DEITY
 - 2. It is a declaration of Christ's RIGHTEOUSNESS
- IV. Divine PROMISES (2 Pet. 1:4)—to be continued...
