 - B. Identifies the cause as "Him who called us"
 - C. Validates His calling "by His own glory and excellence"

 - A. Denotes an ADDITIONAL divine ENDOWMENT
 - B. Identifies the RECIPIENTS as "US"
 - C. Describes the endowment as PROMISES
 - 1. Characterized as PRECIOUS
