- I. The Command for Spiritual Growth (2 Peter 1:5-7)
  - A. The effort prescribed (1:5*a*)
    - 1. Requires an urgent and eager application of energy
    - 2. Accompanies "your faith"
    - 3. Requires personally providing something lacking
    - 4. Describing our experiential sanctification
      - a. Occurs gradually or progressively throughout life
      - b. Increases the believer's practice of holiness
      - c. Requires the believer's submission to God's Word
  - B. The virtues pursued (1:5b-7)
    - 1. [The] Moral Excellence: biblically upright moral character
    - 2. [The] Knowledge: practical discernment between right and wrong
    - 3. [The] Self-control: restraining one's own desires
    - 4. [The] Perseverance: remaining strong in unwelcome toil and hardship
    - 5. [The] Godliness: reverent attitude that seeks to please God in all things
    - 6. [The] Brotherly Kindness: affection for other believers demonstrated by acts of kindness
    - 7. [The] Love: purposefully seeking the wellbeing of the one loved
