THE SURE WORD, PART 1: THE CERTAINTY OF THE APOSTOLIC MESSAGE (2 Peter 1:16-18)

- I. The CHARACTER of their Message (2 Pet. 1:16a)
 - A. What the Apostles' message WAS NOT
 - 1. It was not "cleverly DEVISED"
 - 2. It was neither MYTH nor LEGEND
 - B. What the Apostles HAD NOT DONE—"FOLLOWED"
- II. The CONTENT of their Message (2 Pet. 1:16b)
 - A. What the Apostles HAD DONE
 - 1. They had PROCLAIMED "to you" a message
 - Their message was of "the POWER and COMING of our Lord Jesus Christ"
 - a. Announcing a FUTURE manifestation of His POWER
 - b. Emphasizing His ABIDING PRESENCE
 - c. Affirming Jesus' identity as both SOVEREIGN and SAVIOR
 - B. Why the Apostles' TESTIMONY was RELIABLE
 - 1. They were intimate ASSOCIATES and careful OBSERVERS of Jesus

- 2. They had already seen His MAJESTY
- III. The CORROBORATION of their Message (2 Pet. 1:17-18)
 - A. Christ received HONOR and GLORY
 - 1. BESTOWED directly from GOD THE FATHER
 - 2. Comprised of His DECLARATION
 - a. It was an AUDIBLE voice from OUTSIDE themselves
 - b. It was a pronouncement by "The MAJESTIC GLORY"
 - c. It identified Jesus as God's "BELOVED SON"
 - d. It declared FULL APPROVAL of the Lord Jesus
 - B. The Apostles "HEARD this utterance"
 - 1. Intelligible WORDS were spoken in their PRESENCE
 - 2. PETER was one of those who heard
 - 3. The voice originated in HEAVEN
 - 4. The event occurred at a SPECIFIC LOCATION
 - The central fact is the event's promise and foretaste of Christ's
 PHYSICAL RETURN in GLORY
