THE MOCKING OF THE NAY-SAYERS (2 Peter 3:3-4)

- I. Their COMING (2 Pet. 3:3a)
 - A. Their coming will NOT be a SURPRISE
 - 1. DOUBTERS confronted the OT PROPHETS (e.g., Isa. 5:18-19)
 - 2. JESUS warned against those who DENY His RETURN (Matt. 24:48; Luke 12:45)
 - B. Their coming will CONFIRM Christ's PROMISE
 - 1. Their DENIALS confirm the promises they DENY
 - 2. They will be especially EVIDENT in "the LAST DAYS"
- II. Their CHARACTER (2 Pet. 3:3b)
 - A. They will INTIMIDATE through MOCKERY
 - 1. They are by nature "MOCKERS" or "SCOFFERS" (cf. Ps. 1:1)
 - 2. They are HOSTILE to God's Word
 - B. They will be MOTIVATED by their LUSTS (cf. 2:2-3, 10, 13-14, 18-19)
 - 1. They are driven by STRONG DESIRE to please THEMSELVES

- 2. This is the intentional COURSE of their LIFE
- III. Their CLAIM (2 Pet. 3:4)
 - A. They will MOCK the PROMISE of Christ's RETURN
 - They contemptuously DENY there is any EVIDENCE that He's returning
 - They deride Christians' CONFIDENCE in His PROMISE (cf. Matt. 10:23; 16:28; 24:3, 32-36; Mark 9:1; John 14:1-3; Acts 1:11)
 - 3. They scoff at our expectation of Christ's GLORY
 - 4. They RATIONALIZE their unbelief by REVISING history
 - B. They will DENY the POSSIBILITY of coming JUDGMENT
 - 1. They are EAGER to deny our expectation of REWARD
 - They are DESPERATE to deny their personal ACCOUNTABILITY (cf. Rom. 1:18-20)
