THE EXPLANATION OF THE APPARENT DELAY (2 Peter 3:8-9)

- I. Peter's REGARD for His READERS (2 Pet. 3:8a)
 - A. He REMINDS them of his AFFECTION (cf. 3:1, 14, 17; also 1 Pet. 2:11; 4:12)
 - B. He warns them to stop IGNORING what they know to be TRUE
- II. God's RELATIONSHIP to TIME (2 Pet. 3:8*b-c*; cf. Ps. 90:4)
 - A. God's use of TIME is sometime INTENSIVE (3:8*b*)
 - He can accomplish in ONE DAY what we might expect to take a MILLENNIUM
 - 2. He did so at CREATION and at CALVARY (Rev. 4:11; 5:9)
 - B. God's use of TIME is sometimes EXTENSIVE (3:8c)
 - He may take a MILLENNIUM to accomplish what we thought He would do in ONE DAY
 - 2. He did so concerning Christ's BIRTH and is doing so concerning His APPEARING
 - C. This implies that "the DAY of the Lord" (3:10) will last a MILLENNIUM (Rev. 20:2-7)
- III. God's REDEMPTIVE Purpose through TIME (2 Pet. 3:9)
 - A. He is not LATE in fulfilling His PROMISE

- 1. Some suppose He is LATE because He is NEGLIGENT
- 2. Some suppose He is LATE because He is INCAPABLE
- B. He is DELAYING the exercise of His WRATH
 - 1. He is KEEPING His own SCHEDULE
 - 2. He is demonstrating MERCY toward YOU
- C. His WILL is that ALL would REPENT and that NOT ANY would PERISH
 - 1. Some hold this is His general DESIRE
 - a. "Any" and "all" refer to EVERY HUMAN
 - b. MANY humans will be CONDEMNED (cf. 3:7)
 - c. Therefore, in this matter God's WILL must be THWARTED
 - 2. Some hold this promises UNIVERSAL SALVATION (cf. 3:7)
 - a. All that God WILLS must be ACCOMPLISHED
 - b. "Any" and "all" refer to EVERY HUMAN
 - c. Therefore, EVERYONE must be REDEEMED
 - 3. Best to see this as a promise of salvation of ALL the ELECT (cf. Rev. 6:10-11)
 - a. All that God WILLS must be ACCOMPLISHED
 - b. "Any" and "all" refer to YOU (cf. 1:1, 3)
 - c. Therefore, NOT ONE whom He has CHOSEN can possibly be LOST
