THE RESURRECTION OF CHRIST

(Matt. 28:1-15; Mark 16:1-14; Luke 24:1-43; John 20:1-23)

- I. A Possible Chronology of the Day's Events
 - A. Before DAWN
 - From BETHANY, several WOMEN left to go to Jesus' TOMB
 - At the TOMB there was an EARTHQUAKE, an ANGEL removed the STONE and sat on it, and the guards were IMMOBILIZED by fear
 - a. They saw the tomb was EMPTY
 - b. They saw the ANGEL
 - c. They REVIVED and ran to REPORT what they had seen

B. After DAYBREAK

- Mary Magdalene ran to BETHANY and told PETER and JOHN (probably) Jesus' BODY had been MOVED
- 2. The other women ENTERED the TOMB
 - a. At first, they found it EMPTY and were CONFUSED
 - b. Suddenly, they saw two ANGELS and were TERRIFIED
- One angel announced that Jesus had RISEN and told the women to tell the disciples to meet Him in GALILEE
- 4. The women ran to BETHANY to deliver their MESSAGE
- C. After LEAVING the TOMB
 - 1. Peter and John ran to the TOMB with Mary FOLLOWING them
 - 2. The GROUP of women returning to BETHANY
 - a. Met JESUS, who REPEATED the message they were to deliver
 - b. They reported to the DISCIPLES who did not BELIEVE THEM
 - 3. Peter and John LEFT to return to BETHANY
 - 4. Mary Magdalene STAYED a while

- a. She looked into the tomb and saw TWO ANGELS
- b. She encountered JESUS, who gave her a message for the disciples concerning His ASCENSION
- c. She reported what she had seen, and the disciple DID NOT BELIEVE her

D. LATER that day

- 1. Cleopas and his companion headed toward EMMAUS, about 4 mi. NW
- 2. About 4:00pm, JESUS appeared to PETER
- 3. Jesus JOINED the two on the road to Emmaus, arriving about 6:00pm
- 4. Cleopas and his companion returned to JERUSALEM
- Jesus APPEARED and rebuked them for failing to believe in His PHYSICAL RESURRECTION

II. The Incontrovertible Facts

- A. The TOMB was OPEN
 - 1. Despite the SEAL
 - 2. Despite the GUARD
- B. The TOMB was EMPTY
 - 1. Attested to by the ANGELS
 - 2. Witnessed by the GUARDS
 - 3. Admitted by the CHIEF PRIESTS (who PAID the GUARDS a lot of MONEY to LIE)
 - 4. Seen by the WOMEN
 - 5. Examined by PETER and JOHN (probably)

C. The LORD was RISEN

- 1. He spoke with MARY MAGDALENE
- 2. He spoke with the OTHER WOMEN
- 3. He spoke with PETER
- 4. He spoke with CLEOPAS and his COMPANION
- 5. He met with the Eleven (minus THOMAS) and OTHERS in a LOCKED room
 - a. Where He SPOKE with them
 - b. Where He was TOUCHED by them
 - c. Where He ATE with them
