THE DAY OF THE LORD (2 Peter 3:10)

- I. The CHARACTER of the Day of the Lord
 - A. OT describes it as God's decisive intervention in HISTORY for JUDGMENT
 - It is a PARTICULAR time of FUTURE judgment (Isa. 13:9; Joel 2:1,
 31)
 - 2. It is IMMINENT and INEVITABLE (Isa. 13:6; Ezek. 30:3; Joel 1:15; 2:1; 3:14; Oba. 1:15; Zeph. 1:7, 14)
 - It is described as DARKNESS and GLOOM (Amos 5:18-20; Ezek.
 30:3; Zeph. 1:15)
 - 4. Sinful humanity will experience GOD'S WRATH (Isa. 13:6, 9; Lam. 2:22; Joel 1:15; 2:11; Zeph. 1:18; 2:2-3; Mal. 4:5)
 - 5. God will VINDICATE His people and DESTROY their enemies (Zeph. 1:7-18; Zech. 14; Mal. 4)
 - B. NT applies it to the RETURN of CHRIST and final JUDGMENT (Acts 2:20;1 Cor. 5:5; 1 Thess. 5:2; 2 Thess. 2:2; 2 Pet. 3:10; cf. Rev. 6:16-17; 16:14)
 - It is a series of events encompassing God's PROGRAM for the END OF TIME
 - 2. The wrath of God will be poured out in TWO PHASES

- II. The COMING of the Day of the Lord
 - A. Its coming is INEVITABLE
 - B. Its coming will be UNEXPECTED (cf. 1 Thes. 5:2, 4-10)
 - 1. The unprepared will be SURPRISED and suffer irreparable LOSS
 - 2. The prepared will find BLESSING and REWARD
- III. The CONSEQUENCES of the Day of the Lord
 - A. "The HEAVENS will PASS AWAY with a ROAR"
 - Either the stars and planets will be ANNIHILATED with a universal ATOMIC EXPLOSION
 - 2. *Or* the stars and planets will be TRANSFORMED
 - B. "The ELEMENTS will be DESTROYED with intense HEAT"
 - 1. Either MATTER will be UNMADE by FIRE
 - 2. Or the material universe will be DISASSEMBLED by FIRE
 - C. "The EARTH and its WORKS will be BURNED UP"
 - 1. *Either* all MAN'S WORKS, with the EARTH, will be CONSUMDED by fire
 - 2. Or the SURFACE of the earth will be DESTROYED by fire, exposing the FUTILITY of man's self-exaltation
