- I. God's Love DEFINED
 - A. What it ISN'T
 - 1. Not ROMANTIC FEELINGS
 - 2. Not SELFISH DESIRE
 - 3. Not CAPRICIOUS EMOTION
 - B. What it IS
 - 1. His WILLFUL COMMITMENT to RESCUE the UNDESERVING
 - 2. His DECISIVE INTERVENTION to DELIVER the CONDEMNED
- II. God's Love DESCRIBED
 - A. It is an INITIATING love
 - 1. We are by nature HOSTILE toward Him (Rom. 5:8)
 - 2. His love makes us CAPABLE to love Him (1 John 4:19)
 - B. It is a SACRIFICIAL love (John 3:16; 1 John 4:9)

- 1. He did not give us the WRATH we DESERVE
- 2. He KILLED His SON to provide what we NEED
- 3. He gives it FREELY, but it is far from CHEAP

C. It is an ETERNAL love

- 1. He has loved us since BEFORE He CREATED (Eph. 1:4-5; cf. Jer. 31:3)
- 2. He will love us THROUGHOUT ETERNITY (Rom. 8:38-39)
- D. It is an IMMUTABLE love (Malachi 3:6)
 - 1. It can never INCREASE, since it is already PERFECT
 - 2. It can never DECREASE, since it is FOUNDED in His CHARACTER
- E. It is a POWERFUL love
 - 1. It QUICKENS us from spiritual DEATH (Rom. 3:10-12; Eph. 2:1-5)
 - 2. It OVERCOMES our stubborn REBELLION (John 6:37, 44; cf. 21:11)
- F. It is an INCOMPREHENSIBLE love (Eph. 3:18-19; cf. Isa. 55:8-9)
 - 1. It ECLIPSES and EXCEEDS any human LOVE
 - 2. It SURPASSES human UNDERSTANDING
