THE CLOSING DOXOLOGY (Jude 24-25)

- I. The ABILITY of the One Being PRAISED (Jude 24)
 - A. God is able to PRESERVE us from STUMBLING
 - 1. This is not a promise of SINLESSNESS
 - 2. This is a promise of PERSEVERANCE
 - B. God is able to make us STAND in the PRESENCE of God's glory
 - We will be MADE conditionally BLAMELESS (cf. Heb. 9:14; 1 Pet.
 1:19)
 - 2. We will experience GREAT JOY
- II. The ASCRIPTION of PRAISE to God (Jude 25)
 - A. The RECIPIENT of the praise is GOD
 - 1. He's identified as "the ONLY God"
 - 2. He's described as "our SAVIOR through Jesus Christ our LORD"
 - B. Four specific ATTRIBUTES are praised
 - 1. He praises God's GLORY

- 2. He praises God's MAJESTY
- 3. He praises God's DOMINION
- 4. He praises God's AUTHORITY
- C. The DURATION of God's RULE is ETERNAL
 - 1. It has been His from BEFORE all TIME
 - 2. It is His NOW
 - 3. It will be His into ALL the AGES
- D. The closing "AMEN" is Jude's personal AFFIRMATION
