## JUDAH'S RUSH TO RUIN

(2 Kings 23:31 – 24:17)

- I. The Reign of JEHOAHAZ (2 Kings 23:31-34)
  - A. The general SUMMARY (23:31; cf. 1 Chron. 3:15)
    - 1. He became king at age TWENTY-THREE
    - 2. His reign lasted THREE MONTHS
  - B. His CHARACTER (23:32)
    - 1. His reign is described as "EVIL"
    - 2. His reign is compared to "ALL that his FATHERS had done"
  - C. His REMOVAL (23:33-34)
    - 1. He was TAKEN FROM THE THRONE by Pharaoh Neco
    - 2. Neco charged the nation a FINE of 100 talents of silver and one of gold
    - 3. He died sometime later as a PRISONER in EGYPT
- II. Jehoiakim and EGYPT (2 Kings 23:34-37)
  - A. He was PLACED ON THE THRONE by Pharaoh Neco (23:34)
  - B. He levied a heavy TAX to pay the FINE (23:35)
  - C. He became king at age TWENTY-FIVE and reigned ELEVEN YEARS (23:26)
  - D. His reign is described as "EVIL" (23:27)
    - 1. He paid for a new PALACE through extortion and murder (Jer. 22:13-18)
    - 2. He threatened and/or killed TRUTHFUL PROPHETS (Jer. 26:1-24)

- 3. He despised the PROPHETIC WORD (Jer. 36:20-26)
- III. Jehoiakim and BABYLON (24:1-7)
  - A. Jehoiakim became a SERVANT of BAYLON for 3 years (24:1*a*; cf. Daniel 1:1)
  - B. Then Jehoiakim REBELLED against Babylonian rule (24:1b-4)
    - 1. Jerusalem was ATTACKED by a coalition led by "CHALDEANS"
    - 2. This was the LORD'S doing as PUNISHMENT
    - 3. "The LORD WOULD NOT FORGIVE"
  - C. Jehoiakim DIED shortly before NEBUCHADNEZZAR arrived
- IV. The Reign of JEHOIACHIN (2 Kings 24:8-17)
  - A. The SUMMARY of his reign (24:8)
    - 1. He became king at the age of EIGHTEEN
    - 2. His reign lasted for THREE MONTHS
  - B. The CHARACTER of his reign was EVIL (24:9)
  - C. The SURRENDER of his reign (24:10-17)
    - 1. He surrendered HIMSELF, his MOTHER, and his COURT to Nebuchadnezzar (24:10-12)
    - 2. Nebuchadnezzar looted the TEMPLE and the PALACE (24:13)
    - 3. Nebuchadnezzar also took TEN THOUSAND CAPTIVES (24:14-16)
    - 4. Nebuchadnezzar installed ZEDEKIAH as king (24:17)
- V. Lessons
  - A. Holiness and uprightness can be FASCINATING, but evil is "SHEER TEDIUM"
  - B. God is always FAITHFUL to His Word
