Test Case—"How do I decide when to give to organizations that solicit my support?"

(1 Thessalonians 5:21-22)

I. Recording

- A. Write the above question with the one-word topic: GIVING
- B. List some initial QUESTIONS
 - 1. What biblical principles apply to my MONEY and its USES?
 - 2. What principles apply to an organization's SOLICITATION?

II. Testing

- A. Biblical principles governing my relationship to MONEY
 - 1. Tithing—GIVING to my LOCAL CHURCH (1 Cor. 16:2; 2 Cor. 9:7)
 - a. I must give REGULARLY and PURPOSEFULLY
 - b. I must give JOYFULLY and GENEROUSLY
 - 2. Stewardship—It is GOD'S money, not MINE (Ps. 50:10-12)
 - a. I am ACCOUNTABLE for its use (Matt. 25:14-29)
 - b. I must not be CONTROLLED by it (Luke 16:13; 1 Tim. 6:7-10)
 - 3. Glorification—The goal of its use is the GLORY of GOD (1 Cor. 10:31)
 - a. Includes what is used to HELP OTHERS (Phil. 4:14-19)
 - b. Includes what is used for personal NEEDS or PLEASURE (1 Tim. 6:17)
 - 4. Sowing and Reaping (2 Cor. 9:6, 10)
 - 1. STINGINESS begets LITTLE
 - 2. GENEROSITY begets MUCH
 - 5. Summary principle: "I am responsible to take whatever steps necessary to see that the LORD'S money is distributed properly by ME and used for HIS GLORY"

- B. Biblical principles governing the SOLICITOR'S obligations
 - 1. Legitimacy (2 Cor. 8:16-21)
 - a. With whom is the solicitor ASSOCIATED?
 - b. To whom is the solicitor ACCOUNTABLE?
 - c. By whom is the solicitor ENDORSED?
 - d. For what will the money be USED?
 - e. What is the solicitor's relationship to the CHURCH?
 - 2. Accountability
 - a. What PERCENTAGE of donation actually funds the project?
 - b. By what method will the solicitor VERIFY the money's use?
 - 3. Support Base (3 John 7-8)
 - a. Is this a specifically CHRISTIAN work?
 - b. Who BENEFITS by the donation?
 - c. Who PROVIDES the donations?
 - 4. Summary principle: "The solicitor is responsible to provide a pre-planned method for assuring givers that ALL DONATIONS will be used appropriately for a LEGITIMATE purpose"

- IV. Implementing
 - A. You will not be ABLE to give to ALL legitimate causes
 - 1. Does God DEMAND that I help this cause?
 - 2. If not, do I have a particular DESIRE to help this cause?
 - 3. Might God have brought this cause to my attention because He wants to PROVIDE through ME? (James 2:15-16)
 - B. Decide HOW MUCH to give
 - C. Decide HOW and WHEN to give
