THE WORD AND CREATION (John 1:3-5)

- I. The Power of CREATION (John 1:3)
 - A. ALL CREATED THINGS were brought into being through Him
 - 1. The verb indicates an EVENT, not a PROCESS
 - a. Affirms IMMEDIATE creation
 - b. Attributes it to the DIVINE WORD
 - The preposition indicates His AGENCY as Creator, but not His INDEPENDENCE
 - B. Apart from Him NOT ONE THING came into being
 - 1. There are no ACCIDENTAL/UNINTENDED beings He did not MAKE
 - 2. There are no ROGUE beings (or PARTICLES) not under His CONTROL
- II. The Provider of LIFE (John 1:4a)
 - A. Life EXISTS "in Him"

- 1. Life is nowhere said to have been CREATED
- 2. Life does not exist IN ITS OWN RIGHT
- B. Therefore, He is SELF-EXISTENT
 - 1. He is the SOURCE of life
 - 2. He is the SUSTAINER of life
- III. The Producer of LIGHT (John 1:4*b*-5)
 - A. Light OPPOSES and DISPELS darkness
 - 1. Intellectual light as TRUTH that dispels the darkness of FALSEHOOD
 - 2. Moral light as HOLINESS that dispels the darkness of SIN
 - B. The darkness was INCAPABLE of OVERCOMING the Light
