A MESSAGE FOR THE AGES Background and Introduction to *Daniel*

I. Author (Daniel 7:2, 15, 28; 8:1, 15, 27; etc.)

- A. A CAPTIVE JEW taken to BABYLON by Nebuchadnezzar in 605 BC (1:1-6)
- B. EXISTENCE confirmed by Ezekiel (Ezek. 14:14, 20; 28:3)
- C. PROPHETIC role confirmed by CHRIST (Mt. 24:15; Mk. 13:14)

II. Context

- A. Biblically
 - 1. LXX, Vulgate, and German place him LAST among Major Prophets
 - 2. Hebrew places him with the WRITINGS

B. Historically

- 1. Begins with defeat of JERUSALEM by Nebuchadnezzar in 605 BC
- 2. Ends in third year of CYRUS of PERSIA in 536 BC
- C. Stylistically *apocalyptic* in character
 - 1. Reveals FUTURE EVENTS
 - 2. Uses FIGURATIVE LANGUAGE
 - 3. Emphasizes JUDGMENT and REWARD
 - 4. Deals primarily with END TIMES
- D. Thematically *didactic* rather than *biographic*
 - 1. To ENCOURAGE Israel in captivity
 - 2. To REVEAL details of God's PROGRAM

III. Structure

A. By CONTENT

- 1. Chapters 1-6 are HISTORIC
- 2. Chapters 7-12 are PROPHETIC
- 3. Non-canonical apocryphal ADDITIONS include accounts called *Prayer of Azarias, Song of the Three Holy Children, Susanna, and Bel and the Dragon*
- B. By LANGUAGE
 - 1. Introduction in HEBREW (1:1 2:3)
 - 2. Program for the GENTILES in ARAMAIC (2:4 7:28)
 - 3. Program for ISRAEL in HEBREW (8:1 12:13)

IV. Content

- A. Prophecy
 - Prophecy of world events, LITERALLY fulfilled during the 600 years from BABYLON to CHRIST

2. Prophecy of events yet UNFULFILLED referred to as "the TIME of the END" (Dan. 9:27; 11:36 – 12:13)

- B. Theology
 - 1. God is SOVEREIGN, LOVING, OMNIPOTENT, OMNISCIENT, RIGHTEOUS, and MERCIFUL
 - 2. Christ is coming to DIE, to JUDGE the earth, and to RULE
 - 3. ANGELS serve GOD and minister to MEN
 - 4. Mankind is DEPRAVED and deserves JUDGMENT, yet has opportunity for MERCY and GRACE
 - 5. "At the END of the DAYS" there is coming a RESURRECTION
