Daniel's First Years in Babylon

(Daniel 1:1-21)

- I. Judah's CAPTIVITY (Daniel 1:1-2; cf. 2 Kings 24:1-2; 2 Chron. 36:5-7)
 - A. A PUNISHMENT for SIN
 - B. Included removal of GOLDEN VESSELS from the TEMPLE
 - 1. Implied VICTORY over Israel's GOD
 - 2. Implied SUPERIORITY of Babylon's GOD
- II. Babylon's TRAINING PROGRAM (Daniel 1:3-7)
 - A. Established by ORDER of the KING
 - B. Conducted by Ashpenaz, "MASTER of his EUNUCHS" (literally)
 - C. Intended for SPECIALLY SELECTED young men
 - 1. Must come from the ROYAL FAMILY
 - 2. Must be without PHYSICAL BLEMISH
 - 3. Must be exceptionally INTELLIGENT
 - 4. Must have excellent background EDUCATION
 - D. Designed to train them for ROYAL SERVICE in Babylon
 - E. Included ROOM and BOARD in the PALACE
 - F. Programmed to take THREE YEARS
 - G. Four individuals became SIGNIFICANT
 - 1. Daniel, "God is JUDGE", became Belteshazzar, "May Bel PROTECT"

- 2. Hananiah, "YAHWEH is GRACIOUS", became Shadrach, "Command of Aku" (Babylonian MOON GOD)
- 3. Mishael, "Who is what GOD is?", became Meshak, "Who is what AKU is?"
- 4. Azariah, "The Lord HELPS", became Abed-nego, "SERVANT of Nebo" (SON of the chief god, BEL)
- III. Daniel's RESOLUTION (Daniel 1:8-14)
 - A. Determined to remain UNDEFILED
 - 1. Food was not "KOSHER"
 - 2. Wine and meat had been DEDICATED to IDOLS
 - B. Obedience of these four was DISTINCT from the REST of the captives
 - C. Asked the program DIRECTOR for a special DIET
 - 1. Approached DIPLOMATICALLY, but was DENIED
 - 2. Explanation opened door for a COUNTER proposal
 - D. Asked their personal SUPERVISOR for a 10-day VEGETARIAN and WATER trial
- IV. God's BLESSING (Daniel 1:15-21)
 - A. Passed the FOOD TEST
 - 1. Showed significant IMPROVEMENT over the others
 - 2. Established their PERMANENT diet
 - B. Succeeded EDUCATIONALLY
 - 1. All EXCELLED in EVERY academic study
 - 2. Daniel gifted with SPIRITUAL insights
 - C. Demonstrates God's GRACE in DIFFICULT times
 - D. Shows how God can USE people who are COMMITTED to HIM
