THE WORD'S SUPREME EXCELLENCE (John 1:15-18)

- I. The WITNESSES to the Incarnation (John 1:15-16)
 - A. The testimony of JOHN THE BAPTIST (1:15)
 - 1. A PERPETUAL testimony, a matter of RECORD that remains

RELEVANT

- 2. A PUBLIC testimony, declared OPENLY before many WITNESSES
- 3. A PROCLAMATION of the SUPREMACY of Christ
 - a. Jesus OUTRANKS John
 - b. Jesus EXISTED BEFORE John
- B. The testimony of BELIEVERS (1:16)
 - 1. We have ALL received His FULLNESS
 - 2. GRACE is an inexhaustible SUPPLY
- II. The IMPACT of the Incarnation (John 1:17-18)
 - A. GRACE triumphed over LAW (1:17)
 - 1. "The LAW was given through MOSES"
 - 2. "GRACE and TRUTH were realized through JESUS CHRIST"
 - a. Jesus is the Incarnate WORD, "full of grace and truth"

- b. Jesus is the EMBODIMENT of the grace and truth the Law proves we NEED
- B. GOD was made VISIBLE with a clarity previously unknown (1:18)
 - 1. No HUMAN has ever seen the ESSENCE of Deity
 - 2. Jesus Christ "has EXPLAINED" Him
 - a. He is "the only begotten GOD"
 - b. He REMAINS in close FELLOWSHIP with the Father
