## A TEST OF FAITH

## (Daniel 2:1-23)

## I. A TROUBLED King (Dan. 2:1-13)

- A. DREAMS disrupted Nebuchadnezzar's sleep (2:1)
  - 1. Occurred during the SECOND YEAR of his reign
  - 2. Resulted in a TROUBLED SPIRIT
- B. Nebuchadnezzar summoned ALL the WISE MEN (2:2)
  - 1. *Magicians*: SCHOLARS or SOOTHSAYER priests
  - 2. *Conjurers*: ENCHANTERS or MEDIUMS
  - 3. *Sorcerers*: Practitioners of INCANTATIONS
  - 4. *Chaldeans*: Master ASTROLOGERS
- C. He demanded that they TELL his DREAM and EXPLAIN its MEANING (2:3-9)
  - 1. King wanted to UNDERSTAND the dream
  - 2. Chaldeans offered to INTERPRET it if he'd TELL it
  - King either said his COMMAND was FIRM or that the DREAM was FORGOTTEN
  - 4. King pronounced DIRE PUNISHMENT for FAILURE
  - 5. King announced great REWARD for SUCCESS
  - 6. Chaldeans were CONFIDENT if he'd TELL THEM the dream
  - 7. King accused them of STALLING in hope he'd CHANGE

- 8. King asserted his DECREE was FINAL
- D. Chaldeans CONFESSED their INABILITY (2:10-11)
  - 1. No MAN could do what the king demanded
  - 2. Only a GOD could REVEAL the secret
- E. Nebuchadnezzar pronounced his SENTENCE (2:12-13)
- II. An URGENT Plea (Dan. 2:14-23)
  - A. Daniel requested an OPPORTUNITY to INTERPRET the dream (2:14-16)
  - B. Daniel and companions met to PRAY (2:17-18)
    - 1. The source of wisdom is not the HEAVENS, but the GOD OF HEAVEN
    - 2. Contrasts the MERCY of God with the CRUELTY of the King
  - C. God ANSWERED Daniel's PRAYER (2:19-23; cf. 1:17)
    - 1. Communicated in a "NIGHT VISION," not a DREAM
    - 2. Prompted a HYMN of PRAISE
      - a. Praised God as the Controller of TIME and EVENTS
      - b. Praised God as the Source of WISDOM and KNOWLEDGE
      - c. Praised God for His IMMEDIATE HELP
