

JESUS' FIRST DISCIPLES, part 1
(John 1:38-42)

- I. Jesus and the TWO DISCIPLES (John 1:38-40)
 - A. Jesus' QUESTION for them: "WHAT do you SEEK?" (1:38*a*)
 - 1. He did not ask for HIS OWN benefit
 - 2. He challenged them to CONSIDER their MOTIVES
 - B. Their REPLY to Jesus (1:38*b*)
 - 1. They addressed Him as "RABBI" or "TEACHER"
 - 2. They asked Him, "WHERE are you STAYING?"
 - 3. They implied that they were seeking ASSOCIATION with HIM
 - C. Jesus' INVITATION to them: "COME, and you will SEE" (1:39*a*)
 - D. Their RESPONSE to the invitation (1:39*b*)
 - 1. They went and STAYED with Him that DAY
 - 2. They arrived at about 4:00PM
 - E. The IDENTITY of the two disciples (1:40)
 - 1. One of them was ANDREW (v. 40)
 - 2. The other was almost certainly JOHN

II. Jesus and SIMON PETER (John 1:41-42)

A. HOW he CAME to Jesus (1:41-42*a*)

1. Andrew went to FIND him
2. Andrew told him “We have found THE MESSIAH”
3. Andrew BROUGHT him to JESUS

B. WHAT he HEARD from Jesus (1:42*b*)

1. Jesus KNEW his IDENTITY
2. Jesus NAMED his DESTINY
