## HUMBLED PRIDE (Daniel 4:1-37)

- I. Context and Introduction (Dan. 4:1-3)
  - A. A formal DECREE from Nebuchadnezzar
  - B. A pronouncement of PEACE throughout his kingdom
  - C. An exaltation of "the HIGH GOD"
    - 1. Recognizes His POWER
    - 2. Acknowledges His ETERNAL SOVEREIGNTY
- II. CONFOUNDING the Wise (Dan. 4:4-7)
  - A. A RESTLESS night
  - B. A USELESS exercise
    - 1. Assembled all the WISE MEN of Babylon
    - 2. Told them the DREAM
    - 3. Received NO HELP
- III. CONSULTING Daniel (Dan. 4:8-18)
  - A. A LATE arrival
  - B. A recognized SOURCE of WISDOM
    - 1. Used his HEBREW name
    - 2. Saw his relationship with "SPIRIT of the HOLY GOD"
    - 3. Acknowledged his ability to REVEAL SECRETS
  - C. An account of the DREAM
    - 1. Saw a great TREE that GREW to FILL the earth
    - 2. Heard a "WATCHER" demand the tree's DESTRUCTION
    - 3. Heard the PURPOSE is to prove GOD'S sovereignty to ALL
  - D. An appeal to Daniel to INTERPRET the dream

- IV. COMMUNICATION from God (Dan. 4:19-27)
  - A. A SPEECHLESS counselor
  - B. A COMPASSIONATE introduction
  - C. A DREADFUL pronouncement
    - 1. The tree represents NEBUCHADNEZZAR
    - 2. The dream is the DECREE of the MOST HIGH
    - 3. Nebuchadnezzar will be cut off from PEOPLE and dwell with BEASTS, eating GRASS and living EXPOSED
  - D. A HOPEFUL expectation
    - Nebuchadnezzar will ACKNOWLEDGE God's sovereignty and be RESTORED to his SENSES and his KINGDOM
    - 2. Repentance might REDUCE or POSTPONE judgment
- V. CALAMITY of Nebuchadnezzar (Dan. 4:28-33)
  - A. A COMPLETE fulfillment in TWELVE months, triggered by BOASTING
  - B. An AWARENESS of judgment
  - C. A HUMILIATING descent
- VI. CONVERSION of Nebuchadnezzar (Dan. 4:34-37)
  - A. A restoration of his MIND
  - B. A recognition of God's ETERNITY, His SOVEREIGNTY, His TRANSCENDENCE, and His IMMANENCE
  - C. A restoration of his KINGDOM
  - D. A recitation of PRAISE for God's INTEGRITY, His JUSTICE, and His GLORY
