JESUS DISPLAYS HIS DEITY (John 2:12-22)

- I. An INTERLUDE in Capernaum (John 2:12)
 - A. An IMPORTANT Galilean city in Jesus' MINISTRY
 - B. A visit of unspecified DURATION
- II. The PASSOVER in Jerusalem (John 2:13)
 - A. Participation REQUIRED for all Jewish MALES
 - B. A celebration of their DELIVERANCE from Egyptian BONDAGE
- III. The CLEANSING of the Temple (John 2:14-18)
 - A. ABUSES He observed that day (2:14)
 - 1. SELLING LIVESTOCK in the sacred court
 - 2. EXCHANGING MONEY in the sacred court
 - 3. REVEALING CORRUPTION in the nation's worship
 - B. ACTIONS He took that day (2:15-16)
 - 1. MADE a SCOURGE/WHIP from cords
 - 2. DROVE them ALL out of the temple
 - 3. POURED OUT the MONEY from the boxes
 - 4. OVERTURNED the TABLES in the sales stalls

- 5. Ordered the CAGED BIRDS to be CARRIED out
- C. RESPONSES to His actions (2:17-18)
 - 1. His disciples understood it as FULFILLED PROPHECY (cf. Ps. 69:9)
 - 2. Jews demanded a SIGN to validate His AUTHORITY
- IV. The DECLARATION of His Deity (John 2:19-22)
 - A. Jesus said, "DESTROY this TEMPLE, and in three days I will RAISE it up"
 - 1. Used a word that means "DWELLING place of GOD"
 - 2. Was speaking of Himself as GOD in FLESH
 - 3. Predicted they would KILL HIM and He would RISE AGAIN
 - B. Jews MISUNDERSTOOD, taking it as a THREAT (cf. Matt. 26:60-61; Mark 14:57-58; Acts 6:14)
- C. Disciples REMEMBERED His statement AFTER His resurrection, and BELIEVED (cf. Ps. 16:10; Isa. 53:12; Hos. 6:2)
