## JESUS AND SALVATION (John 2:23-25 and 3:16-21)

- I. The NATURE of True Faith (John 2:23-25)
  - A. Jesus was providing MIRACULOUS SIGNS
  - B. "Many BELIEVED in His NAME"
  - C. Jesus was not "ENTRUSTING Himself to THEM"
  - D. Jesus "KNEW all men," particularly "what was IN MAN"
    - 1. They were merely ENTHUSIASTIC about the SIGNS
    - 2. They did not have TRUE FAITH for SALVATION
- II. The SOURCE of True Faith (John 3:3, 7-8, 15)
  - A. "Unless one is born again, he CANNOT SEE the kingdom of God" (3:3)
  - B. One's being "born of the SPIRIT" is a SOVEREIGN act of God (3:7-8)
  - C. Being born again results in BELIEF in JESUS (3:15)
- III. The OBJECT of True Faith (John 3:16-18)
  - A. God GAVE the WORLD His "only begotten Son"
    - 1. This gift REVEALS God's LOVE
    - 2. Those who BELIEVE in Him "shall NOT PERISH"

- 3. Those who BELIEVE in Him "have ETERNAL LIFE"
- B. For all HUMANITY, there is ONLY ONE Savior
  - 1. The one who BELIEVES in Christ is not CONDEMNED
  - 2. Those who do not BELIEVE are ALREADY CONDEMNED
- IV. The EVIDENCE of True Faith (John 3:19-21)
  - A. Unredeemed people HATE the Light (cf. John 1:4-5)
    - 1. They CHERISH their EVIL DEEDS
    - 2. The Light EXPOSES their EVIL DEEDS
    - 3. Therefore, they "LOVE the DARKNESS"
  - B. Those who are born of the Spirit COME to the Light
    - 1. They PRACTICE the TRUTH
    - They want the Light to reveal that their deeds are the WORK of GOD (cf. Eph. 2:10)
