## THE WOMAN AT THE WELL: CONVICTION (John 4:16-26)

- I. Jesus' CONFRONTATION of Her CONDITION (John 4:16-18)
  - A. Jesus asks her to BRING her HUSBAND
  - B. She said, "I have NO HUSBAND"
  - C. Jesus declared her PERSONAL HISTORY
    - 1. She has had FIVE HUSBANDS
    - 2. She was now LIVING WITH a man NOT her husband
    - 3. Jesus spotlighted both her SIN and her SHAME
- II. Jesus' EXPLANATION of WORSHIP (John 4:19-24)
  - A. She concluded Jesus was a PROPHET (cf. Lk 7:39)
  - B. She raises a long-standing RELIGIOUS CONTROVERSY
    - 1. "Our fathers" WORSHIPED at Mount Gerazim
    - 2. "YOU say JERUSALEM is where people MUST worship"
  - C. Jesus announced the coming END of worship at BOTH LOCATIONS
  - D. Jesus told her the Jews were RIGHT and the Samaritans were WRONG
    - 1. "YOU worship" WITHOUT KNOWLEDGE
    - 2. "WE worship what we KNOW"

- 3. He reminds her that MESSIAH will be JEWISH
- E. Jesus explains NEW TESTAMENT worship
  - 1. True worshipers worship THE FATHER
  - 2. "God is SPIRIT"
  - 3. True worship comes from the DEPTH of one's SOUL
  - 4. True worship meets THE FATHER'S APPROVAL
- III. Jesus' REVELATION of His IDENTITY (John 4:25-26)
  - A. The woman expected the MESSIAH to COME and explain everything
  - B. Jesus declared, "I who speak to you, I AM"
