Daniel—16

PRELUDE TO THE PROPHECY OF SEVENTY WEEKS

(Daniel 9:1-19)

I. God's Punishment of ISRAEL and JUDAH (Dan. 9:1-2)

- A. Occurred during FIRST year of Darius of the Medes
 - 1. After "HANDWRITING on the WALL" in Daniel 5
 - 2. About the time of the night with the LIONS in Daniel 6
- B. Occurred after Daniel READ the prophecy of JEREMIAH
 - Discovered the DURATION of the "desolations of Jerusalem" would be 70 YEARS (Jer. 25:11-12; 29:10-14)
 - 2. Realized that period was NEARLY OVER
 - 3. Began to PRAY earnestly for FULFILLMENT of God's promise
- C. Three principles are demonstrated
 - 1. Daniel expected a LITERAL FULFILLMENT of prophecy
 - 2. Daniel realized the promise would be fulfilled in answer to PRAYER
 - 3. Daniel understood the need for CONFESSION as prelude
- II. Daniel's Preparation for PRAYER (Dan. 9:3)
 - A. He cleared away DISTRACTIONS—
 - B. He anticipated ANSWERS—
 - C. He addressed THE LORD—
 - D. He demonstrated CONTRITION
 - 1. FASTING to avoid distraction of FOOD

- 2. SACKCLOTH to demonstrate abject NEED
- 3. ASHES as symbol of HUMILITY and GRIEF
- III. Daniel's Prayer of CONFESSION (Dan. 9:4-14)
 - A. He exalted GOD
 - 1. Praised His MAJESTY and POWER
 - 2. Praised His FAITHFULNESS to His WORD
 - B. He abased HIMSELF as REPRESENTATIVE of Israel
 - 1. They had committed serious OFFENSES
 - 2. They had acted UNJUSTLY
 - 3. They had behaved WICKEDLY
 - 4. They had rebelled against God's LAW
 - 5. They had ignored God's MESSAGE
 - C. He vindicated GOD
 - 1. God was always RIGHTEOUS
 - 2. All Israel had cause for SHAME
 - 3. God's compassions and forgivenesses were ABUNDANT
 - 4. God's judgment was DESERVED (cf. Deut. 28:63-67)
- IV. Daniel's Petition for FORGIVENESS and RESTORATION (Dan. 9:15-19)
 - A. He appealed to God's PATTERN
 - B. He appealed to God's RIGHTEOUSNESS
 - 1. He keeps His PROMISES
 - 2. He guards His PEOPLE
 - 3. He protects His NAME/REPUTATION
 - C. He appealed to God's COMMAND
