

THE SON AND JUDGMENT  
(John 5:25-29)

- I. SPIRITUAL Resurrection (John 5:25-27)
  - A. The PERSONS resurrected (5:25)
    - 1. When: realized fully IN THE FUTURE, yet experienced IN THE PRESENT
    - 2. Who: Those who HEAR the voice of the SON OF GOD
  - B. The PURPOSE for their resurrection (5:25b)
    - 1. Applied to those who were DEAD (cf. Rom. 6:13; Eph. 2:1, 5; 5:14; Col. 2:13; 1 John 3:14)
    - 2. Making them ALIVE (cf. 1:4; 3:15-16, 36; 4:14; 5:39-40; 6:27, 33, 35, 40, 47-48, 51, 54; 8:12; 10:10, 28; 11:25; 14:6; 17:2-3; 20:31)
  - C. The POWER that resurrected them (5:26-27)
    - 1. The DIVINE provision of LIFE
      - a. The Father is SELF-EXISTENT (cf. Gen. 2:7; Exod. 3:14; Deut. 30:20; Job 10:12; 33:4; Pss. 36:9; 42:8; 66:9)
      - b. The Son possesses THE SAME LIFE (cf. John 1:4)
      - c. The Father granted the Son the AUTHORITY to GIVE LIFE (cf. 5:19-21, 30; 8:28; Phil. 2:6-7)
    - 2. The DIVINE authority to JUDGE
      - a. The Father is “the Judge of ALL THE EARTH” (Gen. 18:25; cf. Judg. 11:27)

- b. The Father granted the Son the AUTHORITY to JUDGE (cf. 5:22)
- c. This authority is possessed by “the SON OF MAN” (cf. Dan. 7:14; Heb. 2:14-18)

II. PHYSICAL Resurrection (John 5:28-29)

A. The PERSONS resurrected (5:28a)

- 1. When: occurs IN THE FUTURE
- 2. Who: “ALL who are in THE TOMBS”

B. The POWER that will resurrect them: His VOICE (5:28b-29a)

C. The PURPOSE for their resurrection (5:29b)

- 1. Grant LIFE to those who did GOOD—as evidence of their FAITH (cf. Matt. 12:34; 15:18-19; Luke 6:45; Rom. 2:6-10; 6:3-5; 1 Cor. 15:16-19; 58)
- 2. Execute JUDGMENT upon those who did EVIL—as evidence of their UNBELIEF (cf. Rev. 20:11-15)
