JESUS, THE TRUE BREAD FROM HEAVEN: BREAD OF LIFE, PART 1 (John 6:30-50)

I. The CONTRAST (John 6:30-33)

- A. They demanded ANOTHER SIGN
 - 1. Those He'd already FED would not BELIEVE without more EVIDENCE
 - 2. Their forefathers had eaten MANNA EVERY DAY
- B. Jesus explained the difference between the SIGN and what it SIGNIFIED
 - 1. The FATHER, not MOSES gave them manna
 - 2. The Father now provides "TRUE BREAD from HEAVEN"
 - 3. The manna provided PHYSICAL sustenance, but God's bread "GIVES

LIFE"

4. Manna was provided for ISRAEL, but God's bread is for "THE WORLD"

II. The CONFUSION (John 6:34-40)

- A. They demanded a CONSTANT SUPPLY of FOOD
 - 1. They demanded it "ALWAYS" or DAILY
 - 2. They demanded He give them WHAT THEY WANTED
- B. Jesus explained ETERNAL LIFE
 - 1. He said, "I AM the bread of LIFE"
 - 2. He would sustain whoever COMES to Him and BELIEVES in Him

3.ALL the Father GIVES Him will COME to Him, and He will cast outNONEwho come

- 4. Because He ALWAYS does the Father's will...
 - a. He could LOSE none of those the Father HAS GIVEN Him
 - b. He would RAISE UP every one on the last day
- 5. Therefore, EVERYONE who BELIEVES in Him has ETERNAL LIFE
- III. The COMPLAINT (John 6:41-50)
 - A. They insisted He was JUST the SON OF JOSEPH
 - 1. How could He be the SOURCE of LIFE?
 - 2. How could He claim to have come from HEAVEN?
 - B. Jesus explained their INABILITY to BELIEVE
 - 1. "No one CAN COME to Me unless the Father DRAWS him"
 - 2. "EVERYONE who has heard and learned from the Father COMES to Me"
 - 3. "He who believes HAS ETERNAL LIFE"
 - C. Jesus repeated, "I AM the BREAD of LIFE"
