RESPONDING TO THE BREAD OF LIFE: BREAD OF LIFE, PART 3 (John 6:60-71)

- I. The Reaction of the FALSE Disciples (John 6:60-66)
 - A. They found Jesus' words UNACCEPTABLE
 - B. Jesus knew they STUMBLED over the TRUTH
 - C. Jesus asked "What if" they were to WITNESS His ASCENSION
 - 1. May mean they'd be MORE OFFENDED
 - 2. May mean they'd BELIEVE Him then
 - D. Jesus identified the SPIRIT as the source of ETERNAL LIFE (cf. 6:53-58)
 - 1. They could not obtain it through their FLESH
 - 2. Jesus' WORDS "are SPIRIT and LIFE"
 - E. Jesus knew who did NOT BELIEVE and who would BETRAY Him
 - F. Jesus explained, "NO ONE can come to Me unless it has been GRANTED him from the Father" (cf. 6:39, 44-45)
 - 1. They were RESPONSIBLE for REFUSING to believe
 - 2. They were INCAPABLE of CHOOSING to believe
 - G. At this, many LEFT and stopped FOLLOWING Him
- II. The Reaction of the TRUE Disciples (John 6:67-71)
 - A. Jesus asked the Twelve to DECLARE their LOYALTY
 - B. Peter AFFIRMED their genuine FAITH

- 1. Identified Jesus as "LORD"
- 2. Asked to whom they SHOULD GO
- 3. Confessed that Jesus' WORDS gave ETERNAL LIFE
- 4. Affirmed their FAITH and CONFIDENCE that Jesus is "the HOLY ONE of God"
 - C. Jesus stated that He'd CHOSEN them as His Apostles, yet one of them was "a DEVIL"
- III. People RESPOND to Jesus in One of Three Ways
 - A. Most REJECT Jesus from the START
 - B. Many FOLLOW Jesus TEMPORARILY
 - 1. They leave when they understand His CLAIMS for HIMSELF
 - 2. They leave when they discover His DEMANDS upon THEM
 - C. A few COMMIT themselves to Jesus in GENUINE FAITH
