FOLLOWING THE DIVINE SCHEDULE (John 7:1-13)

- I. The WRONG Time (John 7:1-9)
 - A. Jesus' AWARENESS
 - [1. He knew the FATHER'S WILL (cf. 6:38)]
 - 2. He knew "the JEWS" wanted to KILL HIM
 - 3. He knew the Feast of BOOTHS was NEAR
 - B. His brothers' ADVICE
 - 1. They told Him to go to JUDEA for the FEAST
 - a. So His DISCIPLES could SEE His works
 - b. So He could PRESENT Himself PUBLICLY
 - 2. They DID NOT BELIEVE in Him
 - C. Jesus' ANSWER
 - 1. He said it was not THE RIGHT TIME
- 2. He explained that the world HATES Him, because He is WITNESS that its deeds are EVIL
 - 3. He told them to GO WITHOUT HIM
 - 4. He said he was not going to the FEAST because His TIME had not yet FULLY COME

II. The RIGHT Time (John 7:10-13)

- A. Jesus' ARRIVAL
 - 1. He traveled PRIVATELY, after the crowds had ARRIVED
 - 2. He entered Jerusalem UNNOTICED
- B. The people's ATTITUDE
 - 1. The LEADERS were SEARCHING for Him
 - 2. Some people thought Him a "GOOD MAN"
 - 3. Others thought Him a FALSE TEACHER
 - 4. There was no OPEN DISCUSSION of Him for FEAR of "the JEWS"
