REACTIONS TO CHRIST'S CLAIMS (John 7:25-36)

- I. Initial CONFUSION (John 7:25-29)
- A. They wondered how Jesus could speak OPENLY when the leaders sought to KILL Him (7:25-26a)
 - 1. Expected the leaders to TAKE ACTION
 - 2. Expected Jesus to be LESS BOLD
 - B. They thought surely the leaders HAD NOT decided Jesus was THE CHRIST after all (7:26b-27)
 - 1. Assumed they knew Jesus' ORIGINS
 - 2. Assumed Christ's origin would be UNKNOWN
 - C. Jesus MOCKED their presumption of KNOWLEDGE (7:28-29)
 - 1. Had not come on HIS OWN initiative
 - 2. Had been SENT by the TRUE ONE, whom they DID NOT KNOW
- II. Divided CONVICTION (John 7:30-32)
 - A. Some sought to SIEZE Him (7:30)
 - 1. Made an UNSUCCESSFUL attempt
 - 2. Made a PRE-MATURE attempt
 - B. Many of the crowd BELIEVED in Him (7:31)
 - 1. Aware of Jesus' SIGNS

- 2. Expected the Christ would do NO MORE than He
- C. The RELIGIOUS LEADERS decided to ARREST Him (7:32)
 - 1. Made STRANGE ALLIES of the Pharisees and chief priests
 - 2. Sent TEMPLE POLICE to seize Jesus (cf. vv. 45-46)
- III. General CONTEMPT (John 7:33-36)
 - A. Jesus SCORNED their attempt to ARREST Him (7:33-34)
 - 1. Would still be "with you" for "a LITTLE WHILE"
 - 2. Would DEPART to the One who sent Him when READY
 - 3. Would be BEYOND their ABILITY to FIND Him
 - B. The Jews MOCKED Jesus' intention to "ESCAPE" (7:35-36)
 - 1. Assumed they could find Him WHEREVER HE WENT
 - 2. Assumed leaving Judea to teach "the GREEKS" was RIDICULOUS
