SIGNIFICANCE OF THE FOUR ETERNAL COVENANTS (PART 2)

I. The DAVIDIC Covenant (2 Sam. 7:12-16)

- A. Provisions of this covenant
 - 1. David would produce a CHILD, yet unborn, who would succeed him and ESTABLISH his KINGDOM
 - 2. This son would build the TEMPLE instead of DAVID
 - 3. The THRONE of his kingdom would be established FOREVER
 - 4. The throne not be TAKEN AWAY, even though his SIN would justify it (1 Kings 11:1-13)
 - David's HOUSE, THRONE, and KINGDOM would be established FOREVER (cf. Luke 1:32-33)
- B. Eschatological implications of this covenant
 - 1. Israel must be PRESERVED as a NATION
 - 2. Israel must have a NATIONAL existence in the LAND
 - David's Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, must RETURN to the earth BODILY and LITERALLY to take David's THRONE
 - 4. A literal EARTHLY KINGDOM must be constituted over which the returned Messiah REIGNS
 - 5. This kingdom must become an ETERNAL kingdom

II. The NEW Covenant (Jer. 31:31-34)

- A. Provisions of the Covenant
 - 1. UNCONDITIONAL and ETERNAL
 - 2. Promises a renewed MIND and HEART
 - 3. Includes FORGIVENESS of SIN

- 4. Promises indwelling of the HOLY SPIRIT (cf. Ezek. 36:27)
- 5. Manifest the TEACHING ministry of the Holy Spirit
- 6. Israel will be blessed MATERIALLY
- 7. Sanctuary will be REBUILT in JERUSALEM
- 8. WAR shall CEASE and PEACE shall REIGN (cf. Hos. 2:18)
- 9. Its foundation will be the BLOOD of JESUS CHRIST (cf. Zech. 9:11)
- B. Relation of the Church to this Covenant—a NON-LITERAL interpretation
 - 1. The church is the new covenant PEOPLE OF GOD
 - 2. Israel was SET ASIDE and REPLACED by the church
 - Therefore, the kingdom of God is NOW, and the "land" is the HEARTS of BELIEVERS
- C. Relation of the Church to this Covenant—a LITERAL interpretation
 - 1. Requires CHRIST as the MEDIATOR
 - 2. Covenant is with ISRAEL, so complete fulfillment will be in the MILLENNIAL KINGDOM
 - Blessings to the CHURCH are based on Christ's BLOOD, shed to make the New Covenant with ISRAEL possible
- III. Summary of Important Features of the Four Covenants (cf. Isa. 59:21; 61:2, 8-9; Jer. 31:35-37; Ezek. 16:60-62; 34:26-27; 36:27; 37:26; Hos. 2:19-20)
 - A. Israel will be a NATION FOREVER
 - B. Israel is promised the LAND FOREVER
 - C. Israel is promised a KING FOREVER
 - D. Israel is promised a THRONE FOREVER
 - E. Israel is promised a KINGDOM FOREVER
 - F. Israel is promised an ETERNAL NEW COVENANT
 - G. Israel is promised ABIDING BLESSINGS
