PREVIEW OF GOSPEL OUTREACH TO THE GENTILES (John 12:17-26)

- I. Various PERSPECTIVES on Jesus (John 12:17-22)
 - A. ENTHUSIASM of the Crowd (12:17-18)
 - 1. Some coming from Bethany had WITNESSED the MIRACLE
 - a. They HEARD Him CALL Lazarus from the tomb
 - b. They SAW Him RAISE Lazarus from the dead
 - c. They TESTIFIED to people they met
 - 2. Many were coming from Jerusalem to MEET the One who "had performed this SIGN"
 - B. REJECTION of the Pharisees (12:19)
 - 1. They had determined to ARREST Jesus (cf.11:57)
 - 2. They feared a REVOLUTION that Rome would CRUSH
 - 3. They prophesied that "the WORLD" has followed Jesus
 - C. INTEREST of the Greeks (12:20-22)
 - 1. They were probably "God-FEARING" GENTILES
 - 2. They approached PHILIP, "who was from Bethsaida of Galilee"
 - 3. They wanted an AUDIENCE with Jesus
 - 4. Philip told ANDREW, and TOGETHER they told JESUS

- II. Momentous PRONOUNCEMENT of Jesus (John 12:23-26)
 - A. Proclamation that His "HOUR" has COME (12:23-24)
 - 1. It is an HISTORIC moment inaugurating PERMANENT change
 - 2. He uses the prophetic title, "SON OF MAN" (cf. Dan. 7:13-14)
 - 3. The time had come for Him to be GLORIFIED
 - 4. His coming DEATH would be His GLORIFICATION
 - B. Provision of a GENERAL INVITATION (12:25-26)
 - 1. The one who LOVES this life is DESTROYING it right now
 - 2. The one who "HATES" this life will GAIN ETERNAL REWARD
 - 3. To SERVE Jesus is to FOLLOW Him
 - 4. The one who will FOLLOW Jesus will be WHERE HE IS
 - 5. The one who follows Jesus will be HONORED by the FATHER
