EXTINGUISHING THE LIGHT (John 12:35-50)

- I. CLOSING the Window of OPPORTUNITY (John 12:35-36)
 - A. The LIGHT would be among them for a LITTLE LONGER
 - 1. God's patience toward the Jews is STILL EXTENDED
 - 2. God's patience toward the Jews will SOON EXPIRE
 - B. They were about to be OVERTAKEN by the DARKNESS
 - C. They must BELIEVE in the Light to become "SONS of LIGHT"
 - D. Jesus "went AWAY and HID Himself from them"
- II. CAUSES of Persistent UNBELIEF (John 12:37-43)
 - A. They COULD NOT believe (12:37-41)
 - 1. Unbelief PERSISTED despite the EVIDENCE (12:37)
 - 2. Unbelief EXPECTED due to PROPHECY (12:38; cf. Isa. 53:1)
 - 3. Unbelief IMPOSED as an act of GOD (12:39-41; cf. Isa. 6:10)
- B. Many of the RULERS recognized the TRUTH but "were not CONFESSING"

 Him (12:42-43; cf. 2:23-24)
 - 1. They FEARED excommunication from the synagogue
 - 2. They LOVED the approval of MEN rather than of GOD

- III. CONSEQUENCES of BELIEF and UNBELIEF (John 12:44-50)
 - A. The BENEFITS of true faith in Christ (12:44-46)
 - 1. Enjoying a personal knowledge of both the FATHER and the SON
 - 2. Being DELIVERED from DARKNESS to LIGHT (cf. Col. 1:13-14)
 - B. The CONSEQUENCES of UNBELIEF in Christ (12:47-50)
 - 1. Characterized as DISOBEDIENCE
 - 2. Will be JUDGED by Jesus' WORDS which they REJECTED
 - C. Jesus' CURRENT ministry was salvific rather than judgmental
 - 1. He came to DIE to purchase our REDEMPTION
 - 2. He'll return to JUDGE those who REJECT Him
