## LOVE'S SUPREME STANDARD (John 13:31-38)

- I. Christ's Love DEMONSTRATED at the CROSS (John 13:31-32)
  - A. "NOW is the Son of Man GLORIFIED"
    - 1. Christ's death SATISFIED the demands of God's JUSTICE
    - 2. Christ's death DESTROYED the power of SIN
    - 3. Christ's death DESTROYED the power of SATAN
  - B. "...And GOD is glorified in HIM"
    - 1. Christ's death DISPLAYED God's POWER
    - 2. Christ's death DECLARED God's JUSTICE
    - 3. Christ's death REVEALED God's HOLINESS
    - 4. Christ's death EXPRESSED God's FAITHFULNESS
    - 5. Christ's death DEMONSTRATED God's LOVE
  - C. "God...will glorify Him IMMEDIATELY"
- II. Christ's Love DUPLICATED in His DISCIPLES (John 13:33-35)
  - A. Jesus will SOON be LEAVING them
    - 1. He would be with them for "a LITTLE WHILE LONGER"
    - 2. "Where I am going, you CANNOT COME"
  - B. He COMMANDS them to love ONE ANOTHER

- 1. It is "new" in its TARGET: "One another"
- 2. It is "new" in its DEGREE: "As I have loved you"
- 3. It is "new" in its MOTIVE: Because Christ loves us
- C. He defines this love as the MARK of the TRUE Christian
  - 1. Demonstrated by willingness to SEEK FORGIVENESS
  - 2. Demonstrated by willingness to FORGIVE
- III. Christ's Love DEPENDABLE in WEAKNESS (John 13:36-38)
  - A. Peter focused on the fact Jesus said He's LEAVING
    - 1. Peter asks, "WHERE are You GOING?"
    - 2. Jesus answered, "You can't follow Me NOW, but will LATER"
  - B. Peter declared himself willing to "lay down my LIFE for YOU"
    - 1. Jesus asks, "Will YOU lay down your life for ME?"
    - 2. Jesus declares that Peter will DENY Him THREE TIMES
