## THE BENEFITS OF JESUS' RELATIONSHIP WITH THE FATHER (John 16:25-33)

- I. The Blessing of Contact through His LOVE (John 16:25-27*a*)
  - A. Jesus had sometimes spoken to them in FIGURATIVE language
  - B. The time was COMING when Jesus would speak PLAINLY
    - 1. Through the ministry of the HOLY SPIRIT at Pentecost
    - 2. Teaching them between His RESURRECTION and ASCENSION
  - C. He would explain their BENEFIT from His relationship with the Father
    - 1. He had told them, "you will ASK in MY NAME" (cf. 15:16; 16:23)
    - 2. He insists He is not the MESSENGER delivering our REQUESTS to the Father
    - 3. The Father responds to our requests because He LOVES US
- II. The Blessing of Confirmation of FAITH (John 16:27*b*-32)
  - A. Jesus SUMMARIZED the central theme of the Christian FAITH
    - 1. He came FROM the FATHER, confirming Jesus' DEITY
    - 2. He came INTO the WORLD, confirming Jesus' DUTY
    - 3. He's RETURNING to the FATHER, confirming Jesus' DESTINY
  - B. The disciples realized He was SPEAKING PLAINLY

- 1. They AFFIRMED their faith in Jesus' DEITY
- 2. They PRESUMED all their questions had been answered
- C. Jesus' notes the IMMATURITY of their DECLARATION
  - 1. They would SCATTER and leave Jesus ALONE
  - 2. Even when they ABANDONED Him, the FATHER would not
- III. The Blessing of Confident HOPE (John 16:33)
  - A. Jesus reminded them of the PEACE He had bequeathed to them (14:27)
  - B. Jesus reminded them of the TROUBLE they'd face in the world (15:18-25)
  - C. Jesus affirmed His coming VICTORY over the WORLD (cf. Rom. 8:38-39)
