JESUS' INTERCESSION FOR THE DISCIPLES AS THOSE WHOM HE WILL SOON LEAVE (John 17:11-19)

I. Their STATUS (John 17:11*a*)

- A. Jesus was "NO LONGER in the world"
- B. The disciples REMAIN "in the world"

II. Their Need for SPIRITUAL PROTECTION (John 17:11*b*-16)

- A. He addressed His request to "HOLY FATHER"
- B. He asks for their PRESERVATION "in Your name"
- C. He asks for their UNITY "in Your name...which You have given Me"
 - 1. Not a visible, but superficial, unity of PRACTICE
 - 2. But an invisible unity of NATURE through REGENERATION
- D. He affirms the SUCCESS of His own KEEPING of them
 - 1. Not one of those "which You have given Me" had PERISHED
 - 2. The "son of perdition" PERISHED in fulfillment of Scripture
- E. He explains their NEED of the Father's PROTECTION
 - 1. To live in His JOY
 - 2. To endure the world's HATRED for having God's WORD

- 3. To fulfill their MISSION despite the opposition of SATAN
- 4. To remember that like Jesus, they are not OF THE WORLD
- III. Their Need for SANCTIFYING PURITY (John 17:17-19)
 - A. They must be set apart "in the TRUTH," which is "YOUR WORD"
 - 1. Through the understanding and application of Bible DOCTRINE
 - 2. Through their RELATIONSHIP with JESUS CHRIST
 - B. They would have a MISSION in the WORLD
 - 1. Jesus was COMPLETING the mission given Him by the Father
 - 2. The disciples are BEGINNING the mission given them by Jesus
 - C. CONSECRATION was necessary for both
 - 1. Jesus could sanctify Himself for His SACRIFICE for our SIN
 - 2. The disciples must be sanctified by the Father "in TRUTH"
