JESUS' INTERCESSION FOR THE *UNITY* OF THE CHURCH (John 17:20-23)

- I. The SOURCE of True Unity (John 17:20)
 - A. This would require the DIVINE work of the FATHER (v. 11)
 - B. He's praying for those "who BELIEVE IN ME"
 - 1. ONLY those chosen by the Father CAN come to Him (v. 6; 6:44)
 - 2. ALL of those chosen by the Father WILL come to Him (cf. 6:39)
 - 3. Every one of the elect MUST BELIEVE
 - C. Their faith would come through the ministry of the APOSTLES
- II. The REQUEST for True Unity (John 17:21*a*)
 - A. We ARE unified by being united in CHRIST
 - B. Affiliation in various DENOMINATIONS is not DISUNITY
 - [C. Paul lists seven aspects of Christian UNITY (Eph. 4:4-6)]
 - 1. All believers comprise "one BODY"
 - 2. All believers are united through "one SPIRIT"
 - 3. All believers share "one HOPE"
 - 4. All believers are united in "one LORD"
 - 5. All believers are united in "one FAITH"
 - 6. All believers are united in "one BAPTISM"

- 7. All believers are united in "one GOD and Father of all who is OVER all and THROUGH all and IN all"
- III. The MODEL of True Unity (John 17:21*b*, 22-23*a*)
 - A. The Father and the Son are unified in MOTIVE (17:1, 4, 5)
 - B. The Father and the Son are unified in MISSION (17:2-4, 6)
 - C. The Father and the Son are unified in TRUTH (17:8, 17*b*)
 - D. The Father and the Son are unified in HOLINESS (17:11, 25)
 - E. The Father and the Son are unified in LOVE (17:24; cf. 5:20)
- IV. The RESULT of True Unity (John 17:21*c*, 23*b*)
 - A. The world may BELIEVE that the Father SENT Jesus
 - B. The world may know that the Father LOVES the BELIEVERS
