## THE CIVIL TRIAL OF JESUS—PHASE 1: JESUS' FIRST APPEARANCE BEFORE PILATE, PART 2 (John 18:33-38)

- I. The INTERVIEW (John 18:33-38*a*)
  - A. He had Jesus brought into his RESIDENCE
  - [B. The Jews had implied Jesus wanted to OVERTHROW Caesar and make Himself KING (cf. Luke 23:2)]
  - C. He asked, "Are YOU the KING of the Jews?"
    - 1. Pilate asked whether Jesus would plead "GUILTY" or "NOT GUILTY" to the accusation of insurrection
    - 2. Pilate seems to have found the claim RIDICULOUS
  - D. Before entering a PLEA, Jesus asked a question for CLARIFICATION
    - 1. If the charge is INSURRECTION against Rome, the plea would be "NOT GUILTY"
    - 2. If the charge is being the Jews' KING, the plea would be "GUILTY"
  - E. Pilate's information came from "Your own NATION and CHIEF PRIESTS"
  - F. Pilate asked, "WHAT have You DONE?"
  - G. Jesus explained that His "KINGDOM is not of THIS WORLD"
    - 1. If it were POLITICAL, His servants would be FIGHTING
    - 2. They would have PREVENTED His being handed over to the JEWS
    - 3. His kingdom is of the SPIRITUAL "REALM"

- H. Pilate recognized the TWO SIDES of Jesus' plea
  - 1. He said, "So you ARE a KING?"
  - 2. Jesus' answer essentially means, "You could SAY SO" or "I wouldn't IT"
- I. Jesus explained His MISSION

**DENY** 

- 1. He said, "I have BEEN BORN, and I have come INTO THE WORLD" for one reason
  - 2. That reason is to TESTIFY to the TRUTH
  - 3. "EVERYONE who is of the truth HEARS My voice"
  - J. Pilate expressed DOUBT that the TRUTH was knowable
- II. The VERDICT (John 18:38*b*)
  - A. Pilate went back OUT to the JEWS
  - B. He pronounced a verdict of "NOT GUILTY"
