The Civil Trial of Jesus—Phase 3: Jesus' Second Appearance before Pilate (John 18:39 – 19:16)

I. Pilate's ALTERNATIVES (John 18:39 – 19:7)

- A. Option 1: Customary release of a POLITICAL prisoner (18:39-40)
 - 1. He suggested releasing "the KING of the JEWS"
 - 2. They demanded he release BARABBAS, a "ROBBER"
- B. Option 2: TORTURE the prisoner instead of EXECUTING Him (19:1-5)
 - 1. He has Jesus SCOURGED
 - 2. They CROWNED Him with THORNS
 - 3. They ROBED Him in PURPLE
 - 4. They hailed Him as "KING" and SLAPPED His face
 - 5. Pilate repeated his "NOT GUILTY" verdict
 - 6. He declared, "BEHOLD the Man!"
 - 7. The crowd roared, "CRUCIFY! CRUCIFY!"
- C. Option 3: Surrender the prisoner to LOCAL authority (19:6)
 - 1. Possibly GRANTING permission for THEM to crucify Him
 - 2. Probably MOCKING their INABILITY to do so
- II. Pilate's ALARM (John 19:7-12)
 - A. Feared he had ABUSED a descendant of the GODS (19:7-12*a*)
 - 1. He asked, "WHERE are you FROM?"

- 2. He REBUKED Jesus' SILENCE
- 3. He boasted of authority to RELEASE or CRUCIFY Jesus
- 4. Pilate's authority had been DELEGATED by GOD
- 5. The Jews' SIN was GREATER than Pilate's
- 6. Pilate tried HARDER to RELEASE Jesus
- B. Feared he would be ACCUSED of TREASON (19:12*b*)
- III. Pilate's ACQUIESCENCE/ASSENT/AGREEMENT (John 19:13-16)
 - A. Sat at the judgment seat to pronounce the FINAL VERDICT (19:13-15)
 - 1. He announced, "Behold, YOUR KING!"
 - 2. They shouted, "AWAY! CRUCIFY!"
 - 3. He asked, "Shall I CRUCIFY your KING?"
 - 4. They declared, "We have no king but CAESAR!"
 - B. Sent Jesus to be CRUCIFIED (19:16)
