FIRST RETURN FROM BABYLON, PART 1 (Ezra 1:1-11)

I. Cyrus's PROCLAMATION (Ezra 1:1-4)

- A. Introduction and background (1:1)
 - 1. Issued in 538 BC, Cyrus's first year of rule over BABYLON
 - 2. Fulfilled God's prophecy of 70 YEARS captivity (cf. Jer. 25:11-12; 29:10)
 - 3. Produced by GOD'S moving "the SPIRIT of Cyrus"
 - 4. It was proclaimed ORALLY and posted in WRITING
- B. The DECREE (1:2-4)
 - 1. Intended to placate the GODS of the conquered PEOPLES
 - 2. PERMITTED Jews to return to Jerusalem to REBUILD the TEMPLE
 - Encouraged those who REMAINED to make GENEROUS contributions to those who were LEAVING
 - a. Gifts for their PERSONAL SUPPORT
 - b. Donations for the TEMPLE

II. God's PROVISION (Ezra 1:5-11)

A. He RAISED UP people WILLING to return

- 1. LEADERS from the tribes of JUDAH and BENJAMIN
- 2. Some of the PRIESTS and LEVITES
- B. God prompted people to CONTRIBUTE GENEROUSLY
 - 1. Personal gifts for the EXPENSES of those RETURNING
 - 2. "Freewill offering" for "the HOUSE of GOD"
- C. Cyrus RETURNED articles from the temple that Nebuchadnezzar had SEIZED
 - 1. Handled by "Mithredath the TREASURER"
 - 2. Transferred into the custody of Sheshbazzar, "the PRINCE of Judah"
 - a. Possibly a Jewish leader to be SUCCEEDED by Zerubbabel
 - Possibly Shenazzar (1 Chron. 3:18), descended from DAVID and an UNCLE of Zerubbabel
 - c. Probably ANOTHER NAME for Zerubbabel
 - 3. Safely TRANSPORTED from Babylon to Jerusalem

III. Lessons

- A. God works through the resources of this WORLD to accomplish HIS WILL for His people
- B. God's WORD will not FAIL
