## THE RESURRECTION OF CHRIST: FACT OR FICTION?

(1 Corinthians 15:12-19)

- I. The FACT of the EMPTY TOMB (Mark 16:1-4)
  - A. Did the disciples STEAL the BODY? (Matt. 18:1-15)
    - 1. Only "WITNESSES" said they were ASLEEP
    - 2. The accused WOULD NOT have done so
      - a. No MOTIVE
      - b. No OPPORTUNITY
      - c. Contrary to their CHARACTER
  - B. Did the Jewish or Roman authorities REMOVE the BODY? (John 20:2)
    - 1. No REASON for doing so
    - 2. Result was BELIEF in the RESURRECTION
  - C. Was Christ in a SWOON from which He REVIVED?
    - 1. Testimony of ALL was to Christ's DEATH
      - a. Professional SOLDIERS who EXECUTED Him
      - b. Both FRIENDS and ENEMIES who watched Him DIE
      - c. Those who PREPARED His BODY for BURIAL
    - 2. CONDITIONS were not conducive for REVIVING
    - 3. Couldn't explain WHAT HAPPENED NEXT
      - a. REMOVED the STONE?
      - b. OVERCAME the GUARDS?
      - c. Traveled miles on NAIL-PIERCED FEET?

## d. Convinced the disciples He'd CONQUERED death and was GLORIFIED?

- e. Only to DIE within the next SIX WEEKS?
- D. Did the WOMEN go to the WRONG TOMB? (Mark 15:46-47; Luke 23:50-56)
  - 1. Opponents need only point out the RIGHT TOMB
  - 2. PETER and JOHN would hardly have made the SAME ERROR
  - 3. This was a PRIVATE burial ground, not PUBLIC
- E. Only adequate explanation is the BODILY RESURRECTION of Jesus

## II. Later EVIDENCES

- A. TEN distinct post-resurrection APPEARANCES of Jesus
  - 1. Varied TIMES
  - 2. Varied PLACES
  - 3. Varied EMOTIONAL STATES of the witnesses
  - 4. Varied CIRCUMSTANCES
  - 5. Varied WORDS and ACTIONS
  - 6. LIMITED in time to 40 DAYS
  - 7. Witnesses were convinced AGAINST THEIR WILLS
- B. The Christian CHURCH grew from this event
- C. The Christian DAY OF WORSHIP established by this event
- D. The NEW TESTAMENT was WRITTEN to attest to this event
- E. The DISCIPLES were TRANSFORMED by this event
  - 1. Had been unwilling to STAND TOGETHER with the LIVING JESUS
  - 2. Now ready to DIE ALONE for the RISEN LORD
