John's Gospel—90 June 30, 2019 AM

MARY MAGDALENE MEETS THE RISEN LORD (John 20:11-18)

- I. She Encountered ANGELS at the Tomb (John 20:11-13)
 - A. Mary was standing OUTSIDE THE TOMB
 - 1. She was ALONE
 - 2. She was WEEPING
 - 3. She stooped to PEEK into the tomb
 - B. She saw two ANGELS seated where the BODY of Jesus had been
 - 1. They asked, "Woman, WHY are you WEEPING?"
 - 2. She assumed Jesus was STILL DEAD, and she couldn't find His BODY
- II. She Met JESUS in the Garden (John 20:14-17)
 - A. She TURNED and saw Jesus, but did not RECOGNIZE Him
 - B. Jesus asked her the SAME QUESTION asked by the angels
 - C. Then Jesus asked, "WHOM do you seek?"
 - D. She assumed He was the GARDNER
 - E. She offered to TRANSPORT Jesus' body
 - F. Jesus then spoke HER NAME (cf. John 10:2-4)
 - G. She called Him "Rabboni" and CLUNG to Him

- H. Jesus said, "Stop CLINGING to Me"
 - 1. He does not mean she can't touch Him YET
 - 2. He means she NEED NOT cling to Him because He isn't LEAVING YET
- I. He sent her to tell "My BRETHREN" of His coming ASCENSION
- III. She Reported to the DISCIPLES What Had Happened (John 20:18)
 - A. She said, "I have SEEN the LORD"
 - B. She REPORTED what He had said
