## THOMAS MEETS THE RISEN LORD (John 20:24-31)

## I. The CLIMACTIC Statement of FAITH (John 20:24-28)

- A. Thomas had not been present on RESURRECTION DAY
- B. The others told Thomas, "We have SEEN THE LORD!"
- C. Thomas REFUSED to believe without SEEING for himself
  - 1. Thomas WANTED the report to be TRUE
  - 2. He needed PERSONAL verification
- D. Thomas was WITH THEM on the next "Lord's Day"
  - 1. The DOORS had been SECURED
  - 2. Jesus CAME and STOOD among them
  - 3. Jesus said, "PEACE be with you"
  - 4. Jesus told Thomas to touch His hands with his FINGER and to put his HAND into His side
- E. Thomas proclaimed Jesus, "My LORD and my GOD!"
- F. Jesus ACCEPTED Thomas's WORSHIP
- G. Jesus COMMENDED Thomas's FAITH
- H. Those who believe without SEEING are BLESSED

## II. The CONCLUDING Statement of PURPOSE (John 20:29-31)

the

- A. Jesus performed MANY OTHER signs John did not report
- B. His purpose was not BIOGRAPHICAL but EVANGELISTIC
  - These were included so "you may BELIEVE that Jesus is the CHRIST, SON OF GOD"
  - 2. He wants you to *believe* so you will "have LIFE in His NAME"
