## THE WORD OF GOD AND PRAYER (Acts 6:1-4)

- I. Biblical EXAMPLES of the UNION of the Word and Prayer
  - A. HEEDING Word is the basis for ACCEPTABLE prayer (Proverbs 28:9)
  - B. ABIDING in the Word is the basis for ANSWERED prayer (John 15:7)
- C. TEACHING the Word and PRAYER are inseparable facets of MINISTRY

  (Exod. 32-33; Deut. 33:10; 1 Sam. 12:23; Dan. 9:2; Mark 1:35-38;

  Acts 6:4)
- II. Biblical PRINCIPLES Regarding the RELATIONSHIP of the Word and Prayer
  - A. The SOURCE of our WISDOM (Acts 1:14-26)
    - 1. Peter and the church APPLIED the WORD
    - 2. They were DIRECTED by PRAYER
  - B. The SUCCESS of our WITNESS (Acts 2)
    - 1. Peter and the church spent MANY DAYS in PRAYER
    - 2. Peter PREACHED the WORD
    - 3. People CAME to CHRIST
  - C. The SECRET of our WARFARE (Acts 4:1-31)
    - 1. Peter and John were ARRESTED for PREACHING the Word

- 2. They WITNESSED to those who ARRESTED them
- 3. They were RELEASED to go to their COMPANIONS
- 4. They all PRAISED God in PRAYER, which was filled with QUOTATIONS from God's Word
- D. The SUPPLY of our WORKERS (Acts 13:2-3)
  - Barnabas and Saul were CALLED to MISSIONARY service while they were ministering the WORD and PRAYING
  - 2. They were COMMISSIONED to missionary service through the PRAYER of the CHURCH
- E. The STRENGTH of our WALK (Acts 20:32)
  - 1. Healthy church GROWTH requires more than ADDITION; it requires NUTRITION
  - 2. The Word of God gives us ENLIGHTENMENT; prayer gives us ENABLEMENT
