WHY *BETHLEHEM*? (Luke 2:1-20)

- I. It's Present Significance
 - A. A city in ISRAEL
 - B. The BIRTHPLACE of JESUS
 - 1. God's PROVIDENCE is evident when we view events as HIS STORY
 - 2. God's PLAN is full of seemingly insignificant details
 - 3. God's PURPOSE is rarely obvious to the people involved
- II. The Providential Sequence
 - A. Introduced as a BIRTHPLACE (Gen. 35:16-19)
 - 1. Originally called "Ephrath," meaning "FRUITFUL"
 - 2. This child was given TWO NAMES
 - a. Mother named him "Ben-oni," meaning "Son of my SORROWS" (cf. Is. 53:3)
 - b. Father named him "Ben-jamin," meaning "Son of my RIGHT HAND" (Acts 2:33-34; 7:55-56; Rom. 8:34)
 - B. Indicated as a place of REDEMPTION (Ruth 1:19; cf. Matt. 1:21)
 - 1. RUTH was a widow from Moab, claimed by ANOTHER
 - 2. She was redeemed by BOAZ, son of RAHAB (Ruth 4:11)
 - 3. She became mother of Obed, from whom came Jesse, from whom came DAVID, from whom came JESUS
 - C. Seen as a place for anointing a KING (1 Sam. 16:1)

- 1. SAMUEL was sent to the household of Jesse
- 2. God identified an insignificant SHEPHERD as KING (cf. Luke 2:7-15; John 10:11-14)
- D. Shown to be a place of REWARD (2 Sam. 19:32-38; 1 Kings 2:7; Jer. 41:17)
 - 1. Barzillai helped DAVID when he was in exile
 - 2. David REWARDED Barzillai's son Chimham for FAITHFULNESS
- E. Seen later as a place of REST (Jer. 41:16-43:7; Luke 2:1-6; cf. Matt. 11:29-30)
 - 1. JEREMIAH, with the King and his entourage, LODGED there
 - 2. MARY and JOSEPH likely visited the same INN
 - 3. JESUS may have been born in a STABLE at that INN
- F. Seen as a place of REJOICING (Luke 2:8-18)
 - Shepherds responsible for the PASSOVER flock REJOICED at Jesus' birth
 - 2. Shepherds had been shown the "LAMB of GOD who takes away the SIN of the world" (John 1:29)

III. A Powerful Story

- A. The Lord Jesus' BIRTHPLACE was part of God's eternal PLAN
- B. Our SALVATION is part of God's eternal PURPOSE (Rev. 13:8)
 - 1. We have the same GUARANTEE of fulfillment (Titus 1:1-2)
 - 2. We anticipate the same GLORY in the future (Rom. 8:18, 28-30)
